In 2020, the checkbox was revised from "Guamanian or Chamorro" to "Chamorro." The Chamorro estimate only includes respondents who selected the "Chamorro" checkbox or wrote in "Chamorro." Caution should be used when comparing the Chamorro estimate in 2013 and 2023.

Notes: The percent change in population is based on unrounded estimates. These estimates represent the race alone or in any combination population which includes those who reported one detailed response, such as Korean, and those who reported multiple responses, such as Korean and Vietnamese or Korean and Black or African American.
