ACS Basics: The Survey

- Ongoing survey that samples about 3.5 million addresses per year
- Designed to produce critical information that was previously collected in the decennial census
- Fully implemented in 2005
- Collects data on a wide range of demographic, social, economic, and housing characteristics
- Publishes annual estimates for small geographic areas and population groups



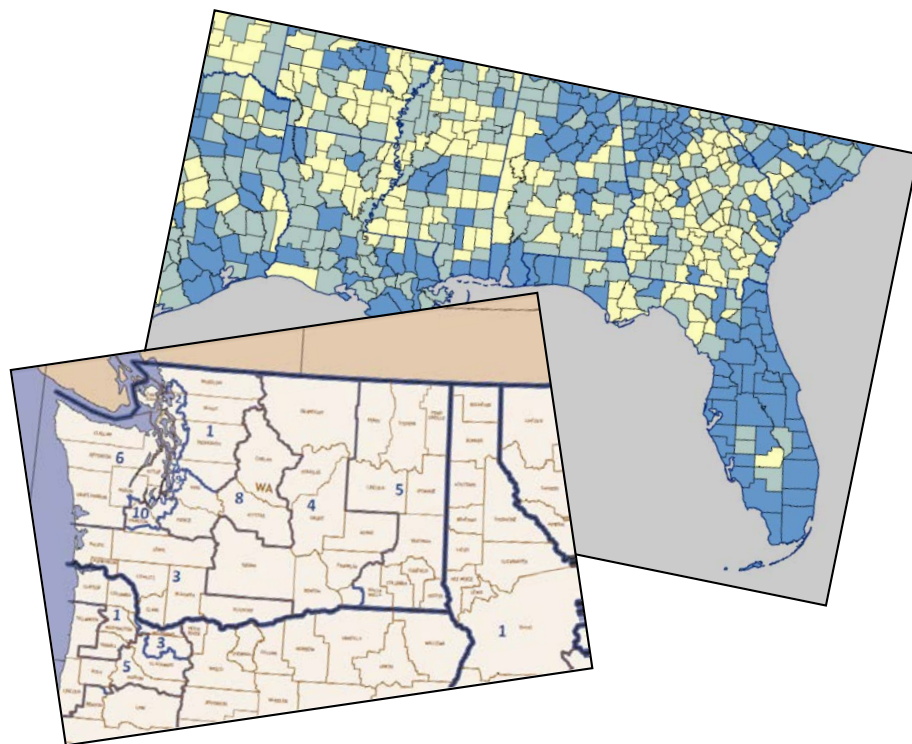

ACS Geography Update

- Boundary and Annexation Survey (BAS) suspended in 2014
- 2014 ACS estimates:
 - Do not reflect boundary updates from legal annexations
 - Do include new incorporations, disincorporations, and legal name changes

Guidance for ACS Users

- ✓ Compare across geographies and population subgroups using 2014 ACS
- ✓ Compare 2013 ACS and 2014 ACS estimates but use caution when comparing
 - Income, Earnings, and Poverty
- ✓ Compare percentages, means, medians, and rates instead of totals whenever possible
- ⚠ Don't expect ACS estimates to match decennial census counts or estimates from other surveys

CPS vs. ACS

- Income, poverty, and health insurance estimates from the 2014 CPS will be released Wednesday, September 16th
- Estimates from CPS and ACS differ for a number of reasons, but trends over time tend to be similar across the surveys
- Recommendations:
 - National estimates → CPS
 - Subnational estimates → ACS

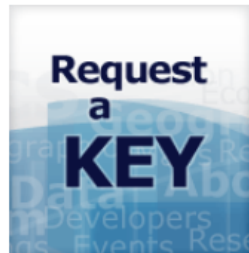

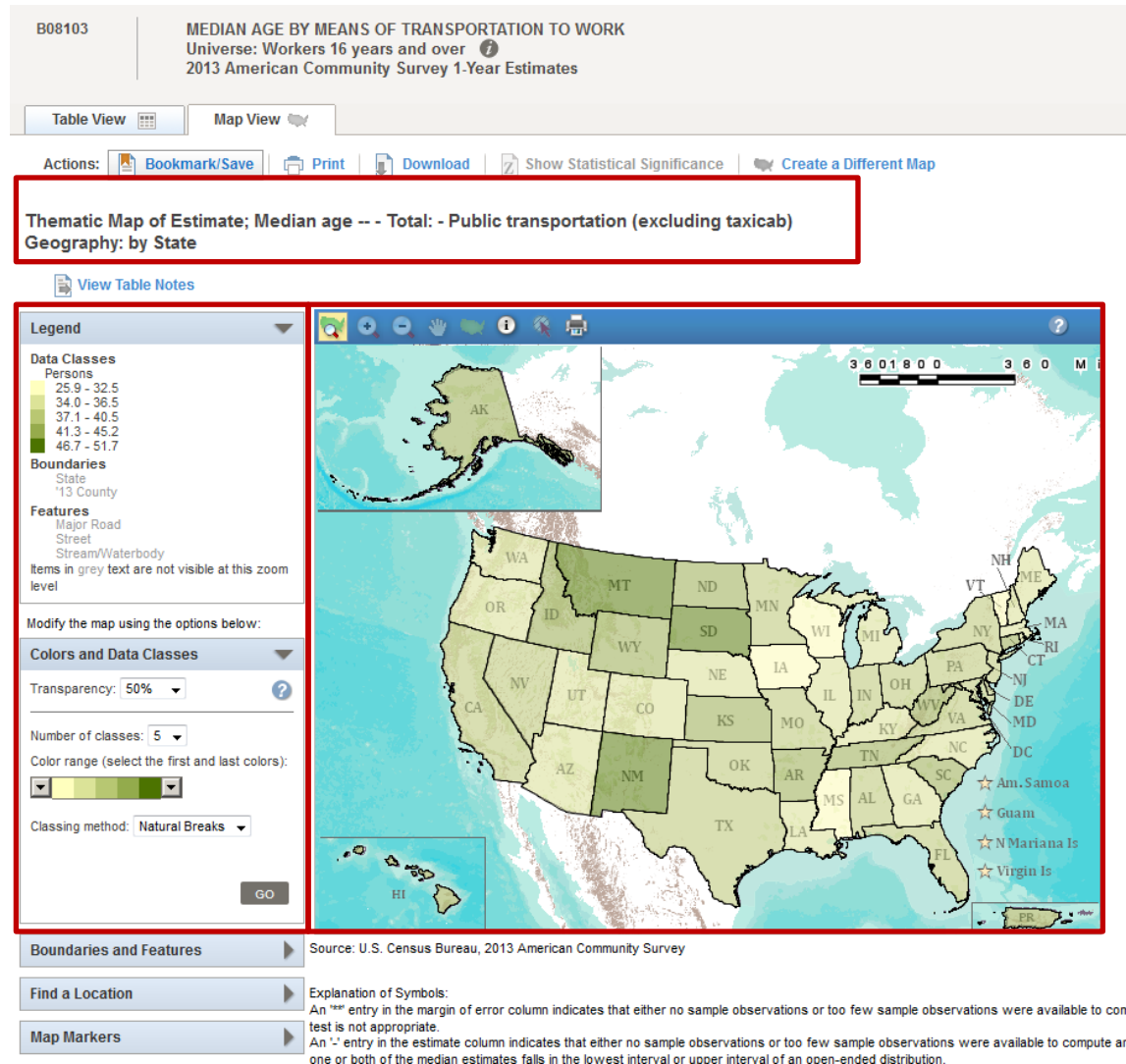
